Example #1: (290 words) Hilary Gainey, Female, Adult

My name is Hilary Gainey and I am 28 years old. Despite being baptized as an infant in a "big brand name" Church, my parents did little to foster a relationship between myself and Jesus. Example #2: (250 words) Ryan Rayburn, Male, Adult

My name is Ryan Rayburn. I grew up in a non-religious home never speaking of God or Jesus Christ. Until 4 years ago I lived life my way, not at all the way God wanted me to. I knew about God, sometimes even felt God but lacked a personal relationship with Him. When everything started to fall apart I knew I needed something more for my life, so I started attending church on my own. I remember one service where Jamie spoke about Grace. This was the first time I really knew or felt what Grace meant. I remember at that service telling God that I am finally giving Him control and wanting to follow His plan for my life. That was the day that I accepted Jesus Christ as my Lord and Savior and thanked Him for dying for my sins so that I can come to have a personal relationship with Him. Through God's redeeming love I am now engaged to a wonderful woman and cannot wait to see what Jesus has in store for my future. I am being baptized today to show my unwavering obedience to Jesus Christ and to show others that Jesus is my Lord and savior.

Example #3: (197 words) Halle Rankin, female, child

I've been going to Scottsdale Bible since I was born, and I was always taught about God by my mother and father. I really never thought about Jesus until I got older.
